Presentation of the Dual Training Project (DUAL - T)

The project has been designed to research and to transfer all good practices that have been developed in dual VET in countries that have implemented it. With the results of this research will be elaborated materials for tutors and student and will be made a pilot experience on three industrial sectors (Metal, construction and food). The result of the pilot experience will be collected in a Guide, establishing a methodology for the imparting of dual training in enterprises. All educational materials will be defined under the EUROPASS APPRENTICE ACCREDITATION.

The consortium is formed by partners from countries with a successful experience in Dual training and partners from countries with the need of knowing and introduces such a system that has proven to be so successful in those that already have it. CEOE commitment to Dual Vocational Training

Dual Vocational Training is confirmed as one of the best educational options for young people who want to enter the labor market. Therefore, from CEOE is being carried out several projects related to Dual Vocational Training in Spain, in addition to **Dual-T project**.

One such initiative is the **Global Learning Network (GAN)**, which was created in order to meet any future requirements of qualified personnel in enterprises.

Another initiative is the agreement between CEOE and the **Bertelsmann Foundation**, to boost the Dual Training in companies, dissemination, identification of new occupations and job profiles, among other things.

Training CEOE commitment to dual vocational training initiatives such as the Global Learning Network (GAN), which was created as with the aim of meeting the future needs of qualified personnel in businesses and create employment opportunities for young people (worldwide).

The CEOE commitment to dual FP internationally

This project is intended as a "practical guide" based on the best practices of network members and a simple tracking system which is already being developed to monitor progress in offering training opportunities for youth work worldwide.

The "Partnership for Professional Driver Training" (nationally) is another network of institutions and companies committed to the development of this type of training, driven by the Bertelsmann Foundation, the Foundation Princess of Girona, CEOE and the Chamber of Commerce from Spain; looking to implement in our country a model of dual FP quality adapted to the Spanish context.

The four promotional organizations find it necessary to make a commitment to training, structured similar to that used in Germany, which suits the demands of working to reduce the high unemployment rate in the age group dual system that ranges from 15 to 25 years, located in 51.4%.

36 month pilot project

Also, CEOE leads the European project "Dual-Training (Dual-T)", whose initial objective is research and the transfer of best practices developed in Dual FP in countries that have implemented in Europe, with the participation of different European organizations: Liber

Training Centre (Spain); Handwerkskammer Potsdam (Germany); Centro per lo Sviluppo e delle Imprese L'Innovazione - Società Cooperativa (Italy); 609 Consorzio Coop. Soc (Italy); UK and Europe S.L. (Romania). This project has a duration of 36 months. After an initial phase in which European best practices collected, the results will be the basis for the development of materials.

Then the young pass to another phase, which will hold a training pilot experience in three European countries simultaneously (Spain, Italy and Romania) and three industrial sectors (metal, construction and food). The participation of about 100 young Europeans in this pilot project, with a duration of 24 months is expected.

Since CEOE perceived as a good opportunity for business organizations to take a role in relation to the intermediation between companies, training centers and students, as in other European countries.

Juan Carlos Tejada, new managing director of Ceoe Cepyme Training, said that "*the path left ahead is still very long and uncertain. Against enrollment in Dual Vocational Training in Spain in 2012 of 1% of Germany was by 42%* "
