

Collection of good practices and indicators

The collection of good practices of dual vocational training, has been based on a series of indicators that will allow for the comparison of the results in each of the countries analyzed.

These indicators, are trying to identify: definition of the position of learning, the role of tutors, how is the relationship between the trainee and the enterprise, the financing of that relationship, local, regional, or State regulations that guide the process of dual training, responsible agencies and the level of qualification and his ordination on the European qualifications framework. CEOE takes part in the first forum of the alliance for dual of the alliance for Dual Vocational Training.

CEOE has participated during the 19th and 20th of October in the I Forum of the Alliance for the Dual professional training, in Palma de Mallorca.

The Dual professional training Alliance is a statewide network of companies, centers and institutions committed to the development of the Dual FP in Spain, driven by the Bertelsmann Foundation, together with the Foundation Princess of Girona, CEOE and Spain Chamber of Commerce.

Speakers at the Forum, it highlighted the presence of executives of companies, training institutions, industry associations, of the representation of students and institutions involved in the Dual FP. All of them agreed on the benefits and virtues of the FP Dual for the employability of young people, the competitiveness of enterprises and society in general, while it is necessary to

develop a State common framework that serves to bring order to the diversity of regional regulations.

In Spain, according to data provided during the Forum, there are more than 700 centres offering FP Dual, close to 5,000 companies involved and 16,000 students participating.

Finally, the training director of CEOE, Juan Carlos Tejeda, together with the representatives of the founding of the Alliance, presented commemorative plaques to the companies participating in the Alliance.



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
